## Guidelines

***Due Date: December 16, 2010***

### Description of Assignment

Social studies requires one to develop cultural awareness. As a result, this course requires one to undertake an activity that helps develop said awareness.

### Description of Assignment

- The Student will attend one arts/historical event/exhibit/government operations meeting during the semester.
- The student shall write a short paper about the experience following the guidelines noted below and relate it to themes/events/concepts from the course.
- The event/activity **must be approved** by Mr. Schumann **beforehand**
- The event/activity **may not be** a school event (play, concert, etc.)
- Provide documentation of your visit (flyer, program, pictures, etc.,)
- Sample events may include but at not limited to:
  - Art Exhibit/Museum
  - Historical Exhibit/Museum
  - Dance/Theatre/Opera Event
  - Historical Reenactment
  - Community Event (Apple Festival, etc.)
  - Government meeting (school board, city council, etc.)

### Extra Credit

Extra credit (20%) may be earned if a parent/guardian also attends the event. A student may gain this credit said parent/guardian will have to turn in a half page paper (may be handwritten) about their experience. ***This paper must be signed by said parent/guardian.***

### Guidelines

- What to turn in:
  - Program/Flier/Promotional Literature
  - Student Paper Describing Event/What Witnessed
    - Note any connections to philosophical, cultural, or governmental issues as they relate to some aspect of European history/culture/philosophy/government.
- Length: 1 ½ - 2 Pages
  - Double Spaced
  - Times New Roman or Arial Font (12 point)
  - 1" Margins (left, right, top, bottom)
